Governing Board Vacancy – Co-opted Governor

We currently have a vacancy on our Governing Board for a **Co-opted Governor**.

A co-opted governor is a member of the governing body appointed by the board because they have specific skills, experience, or local knowledge that can help support the school's success. The term of office can be up to **four years**. Co-opted governors are not elected by parents or staff, but are selected to fill particular expertise gaps and always act in the best interests of the school.

At present, the governing body is particularly interested in hearing from individuals with experience in:

- Procurement
- Health and Safety
- Project management
- Chairing meetings

Parents are very welcome to apply; however, these roles are open to anyone with the relevant skills who would like to support the local community. Many businesses actively encourage employees to take on governor roles, so if you are interested, or know someone who might be, please do share this opportunity.
