A polite reminder that on days when children are not taking part in PE, they should be wearing full school uniform, including trousers (not joggers) and black school shoes.

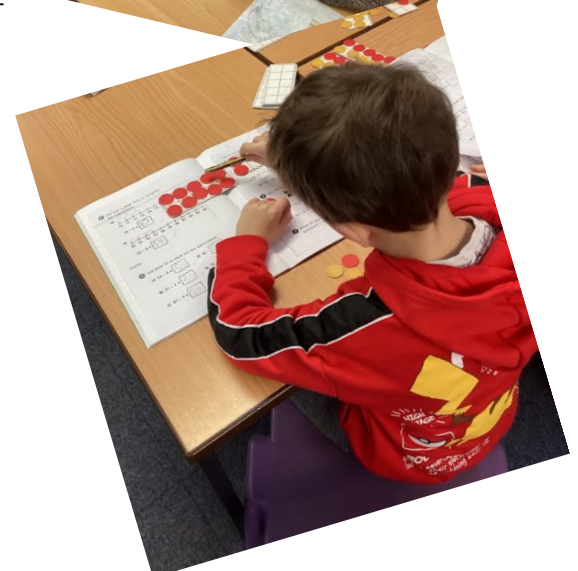
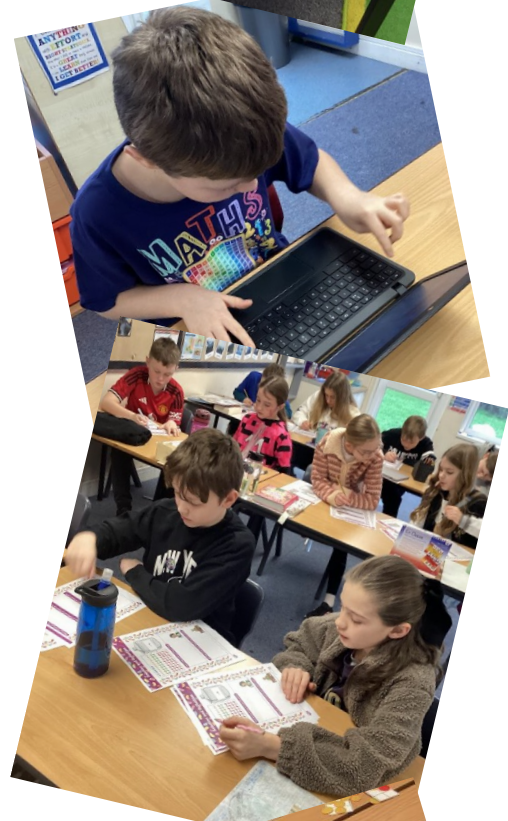
On PE days, children should wear plain joggers and a plain white T-shirt.
