Dear Parents and Carers

On **Wednesday 1st July** a trip has been arranged for the children in the Hedgehogs Class to visit Skegness. The children will be able to build on the work covered, and knowledge learnt, as part of their topic Geography topic 'What can you see at the coast?'. We will be joined on the coach by the Rabbits Class who are also visiting Skegness to support their learning this term.

We will spend the day exploring the key human and physical features of the coastal town such as the park, the promenade and the beach, and investigate how people use the local coast. Finally, we will enjoy an ice-cream treat by the beach before we board the coach back to school.

We will leave school by coach at **9am**, so please be at the main school entrance no later than **8.40** so that we can register and board the coach in good time. We aim to return to school by **3.30 pm**.

Children are to wear school uniform on the day. Please ensure that they have sun cream on and a hat, sensible footwear for walking and a raincoat just in case! Please bring a packed lunch, snacks and drinks in a named bag. Alternatively, you will be able to order a packed lunch from Kidz Kitchen, however extra drinks and snacks will need to be brought from home as it will be a long day for the children. Children can also bring in a named bucket and spade for our time on the beach.

The cost of the trip is, kindly, being covered by our school PTA and by the JMJ Trust. Your child will not require any spending money.

We do need volunteers to come and help on the visit so please let me know, as soon as possible, if you are able to help.
