Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to confirm the arrangements for our Year 6 residential trip to London, taking place on Wednesday 24th June and Thursday 25th June 2026. The visit promises to be an exciting and educational experience, giving pupils the opportunity to explore some of London's most famous attractions and landmarks.

Please find the itinerary below:

WEDNESDAY 24TH JUNE 2026

07:15 - Coach arrives at school for luggage loading. Please arrive promptly so that we can leave on time. The coach will be parked in the village hall.

07:30 - Depart from the village hall for London

Lunch (Please provide the children with a packed lunch)

12:30 - Visit to the Science Museum, Exhibition Road, South Kensington, London SW7 2DD

• Hands-on Wonderlab session - the children will take part in an exciting session at 1pm

14:30 - Visit to the Natural History Museum, Cromwell Road, London SW7 5BD

16:30 - Walk to restaurant (10 minutes)

16:45 - Evening meal at Pizza Express 88 Cromwell Rd, South Kensington, London SW7 4EN

Dinner - The children have selected their choices.

18:15 - Rejoin the coach and travel to the theatre

19:30 - West End theatre performance - Apollo Victoria Theatre, 17 Wilton Rd, London SW1V 1LG

22:00 - Rejoin the coach

22:20 - Check in at the hostel and settle for the night -YHA London Central, 104 Bolsover St, London W1W 5NU

THURSDAY 25TH JUNE 2026

08:30 - Breakfast served and packed lunches collected

09:30 - Check out, load the coach and depart for the Imperial War Museum

10:15 - Visit to the Imperial War Museum, Lambeth Road, London SE1 6HZ

12:00 - Walk to the London Eye Pier

12:30 - Check in for River Thames Cruise

12:45 - 40-minute River Thames sightseeing cruise with commentary

Lunch - Eat packed lunches (provided by YHL) while on board

11:30 - Return to London Eye Pier

14:15 - Check in for the London Eye

14:30 - Flight on the London Eye

13:30 - Depart London and begin journey back to school



A suitable stop will be made at motorway services on the return journey where pupils will purchase an evening meal.

20:30 (approximately) - Arrive back at school

Additional Information

Pupils should bring an overnight bag, toiletries and nightwear (see packing list)

Medication

Any medication must be clearly labelled and handed to a member of staff before departure.

Electronic Devices

For the safety and wellbeing of all pupils, electronic devices are strictly prohibited on this trip. Mobile phones, tablets, smart watches, handheld gaming devices and any other electronic equipment must not be brought. Any electronic devices found during the visit will be confiscated and returned at the end of the trip. Digital cameras are also not permitted.

The safety of all children remains our highest priority. Staff will be taking plenty of photographs throughout the visit, including both individual and group photographs. Regular updates and photographs will be shared during the trip via our school/class Instagram page, allowing parents and carers to follow our adventures.

Following the trip, all photographs will be uploaded to a secure shared drive. Access will only be granted to parents and carers of children attending the visit.

Money

Your child will not be required to bring any money with them (apart from the £10 for food - see below) as there will be no time to stop in shops for souvenirs.

Packing Information

Please ensure all items are clearly labelled with your child's name.

Children should arrive at school on Wednesday morning wearing the clothes they will wear throughout the day in London. As there will be a considerable amount of walking, comfortable clothing and sensible footwear are essential.

What to Wear on Wednesday

- ✓ Comfortable clothes suitable for a full day of activities
- ✓ Trainers or other sensible walking shoes
- ✓ A lightweight jacket or waterproof coat (weather dependent)



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Bag 1 - Overnight Bag (for the hostel)

- ✓ Pyjamas
- ✓ Clothes for Thursday:
- Shorts or trousers (depending on the weather)
- T-shirt/top
- Jumper or hoodie
- Underwear and socks
- ✓ Toiletries:
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Shower gel
- Deodorant
- Hairbrush/comb
- Any other personal toiletries required
- ✓ Small towel (if required)

Bag 2 - Small Rucksack (to carry during the trip)

- ✓ Packed lunch for Wednesday
- ✓ Reusable water bottle
- ✓ Waterproof coat that can fit inside the bag
- ✓ Sun cream
- ✓ Small jacket or jumper if required

Important Notes

- Children will carry their rucksack throughout both days, so please ensure it is comfortable and not too heavy.
- Please avoid bringing unnecessary valuables.
- Any medication must be handed to a member of staff before departure and be clearly labelled.
- We recommend checking the weather forecast closer to the trip and adjusting clothing accordingly.

Food

WEDNESDAY 24TH JUNE

Breakfast

Please ensure your child has eaten breakfast before arriving at school. As we have an early departure, you may also wish to provide a small healthy snack or breakfast bar for the coach journey.

Lunch

Children will need to bring a packed lunch from home for Wednesday. We will eat this upon our arrival in London. Please ensure the lunch is packed in your child's rucksack.



Dinner

We will be eating at Pizza Express on Wednesday evening. All children have already selected their main course, dessert and drink choices.

Theatre Treat

When attending the theatre, children may bring one small treat to enjoy. This could be a small packet of sweets, a snack-sized bag of popcorn or a similar item. Please be reasonable with portion sizes as we will not be eating throughout the performance.

THURSDAY 25TH JUNE

Breakfast

Breakfast will be provided at the YHA hostel before we begin our day's activities.

Packed Lunch

The hostel will provide a packed lunch for each child. All children have already selected their sandwich choice.

Evening Meal

On our journey home, we will stop at a motorway service station. We are hoping to stop at a service station with a McDonald's or similar food outlet.

As this meal is not included in the cost of the trip, please provide your child with a £10 note in the envelope provided. On the outside of the envelope, please clearly write your child's usual McDonald's order. This helps staff organise food orders quickly and efficiently.

Any change will be placed back into the envelope and returned home with your child.

Additional Snacks and Drinks

If your child is a particularly fussy eater, you may wish to pack a few additional snacks in their rucksack. Please remember:

- Do not pack items that may melt on a warm day.
- Snacks should be sensible and easy to carry.
- Children will be carrying their rucksacks throughout much of the visit, so please avoid packing unnecessary items.

Please ensure your child brings a reusable water bottle that can be refilled throughout the trip. Staying hydrated will be especially important as we will be walking considerable distances over both days.
